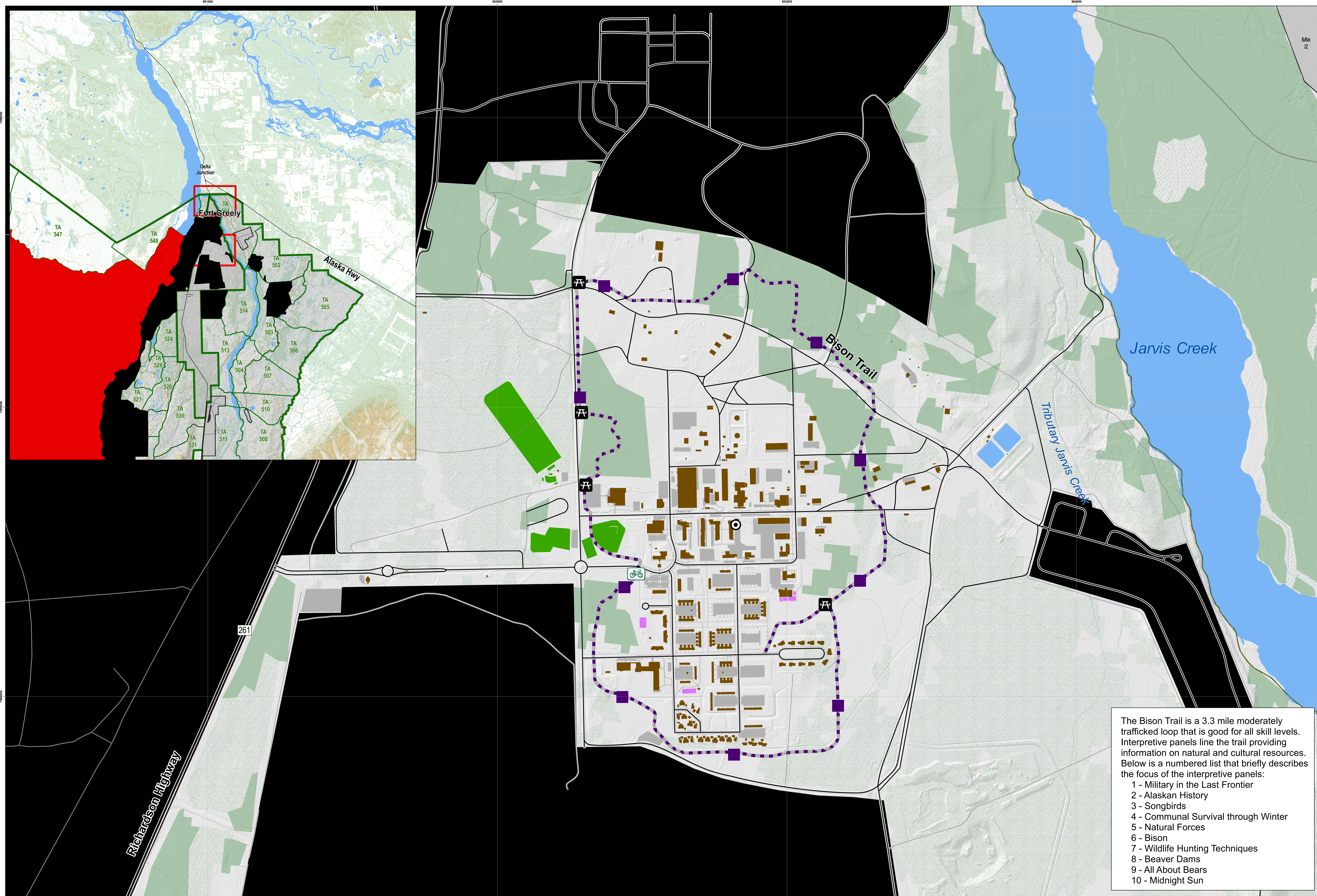


# Any person recreating on Army Training Land must check-in on USAG Alaska iSportsman



The Bison Trail is a 3.3 mile moderately trafficked loop that is good for all skill levels. Interpretive panels line the trail providing information on natural and cultural resources. Below is a numbered list that briefly describes the focus of the interpretive panels:

Prior to recreating on USAG Alaska land all users 16 years or older are required to obtain a Sikes Act Permit (SAP) and check-in on iSportsman. You can check-in online or by phone.

To check-in using the phone, you will need your SAP number and 4-digit PIN.

### Phone System Options:

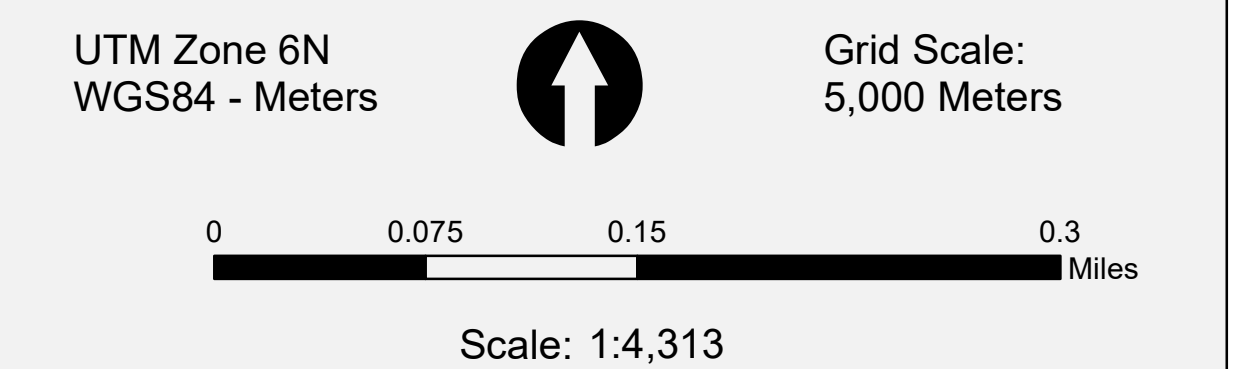
1. Check-In
  - A. Enter your SAP number and press #
  - B. Enter your check-in PIN
  - C. Would you like to add additional permit numbers if traveling in a group?
  - D. Enter the number of days you plan to say (you must choose from 1-14)
  - E. Choose an activity from your list of choices
  - F. Enter your training areas 3 digit ID
2. Listen for a list of closed areas
