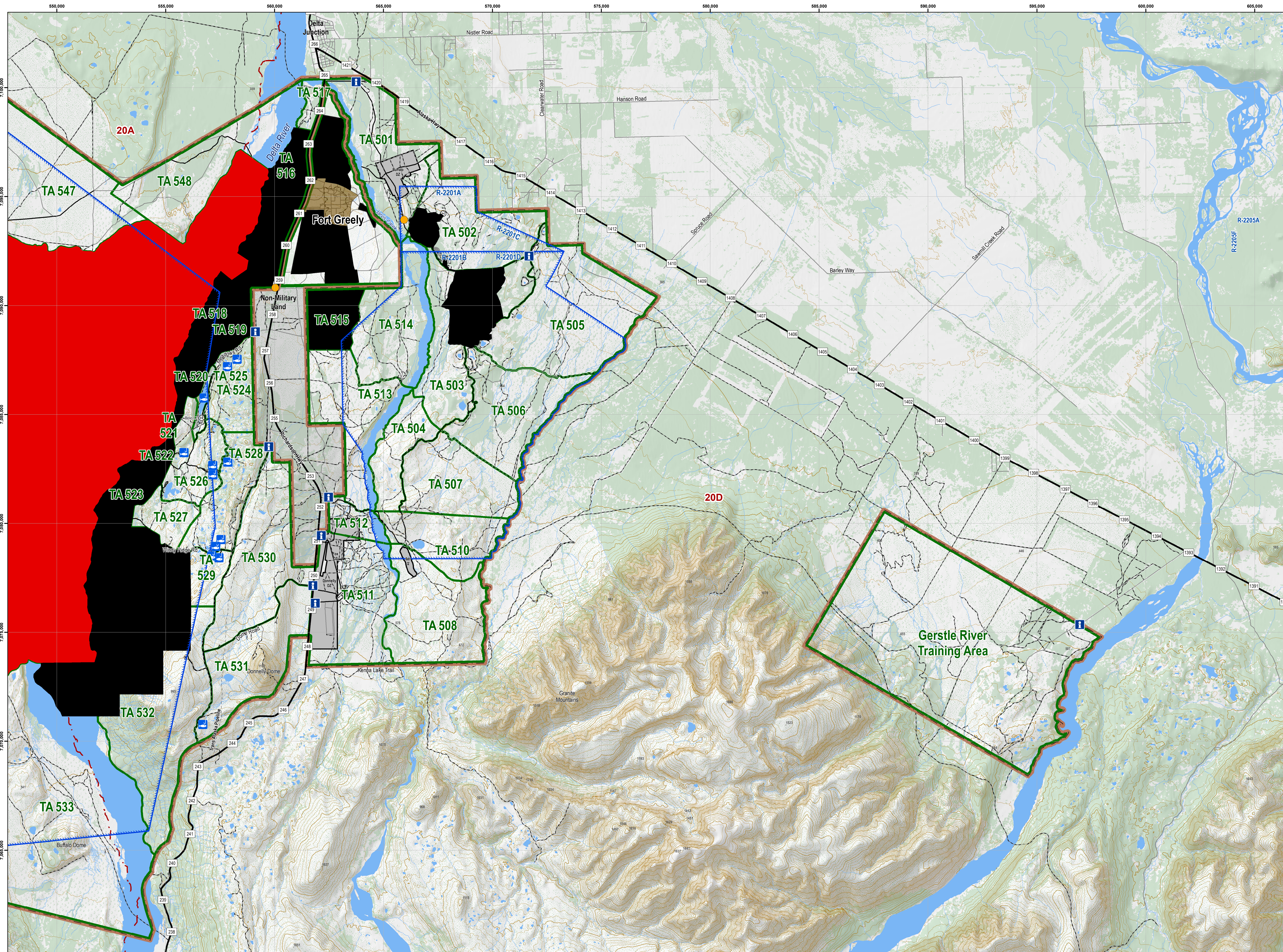


# Any person recreating on Army Training Land must check-in on USAG Alaska iSportsman

Prior to recreating on USAG Alaska land, all users are required to check-in on iSportsman. You can check-in online or by phone.

All recreations users, 16 years or older, must obtain a Recreation Access Permit (RAP).

  - Reprint existing RAP cards or obtain a screenshot of existing RAP card on your smart phone
  - Purchase Wood Cutting Permits with a credit card
  - Register for Bear Baiting and Trapping Permits
  - View and print USAG Alaska Reference Maps

### Telephone Check-in System

To check-in using the phone, you will need your RAP number and 4-digit PIN.

- Phone System Options:**
1. Check-In
    - A. Enter your RAP number and press #
    - B. Enter your check-in PIN
    - C. Would you like to add additional permit numbers if traveling in a group?
    - D. Enter the number of days you plan to stay (you must choose from 1-14)
    - E. Choose an activity from your list of choices
    - F. Enter your training areas 3 digit ID
  2. Listen for a list of closed areas

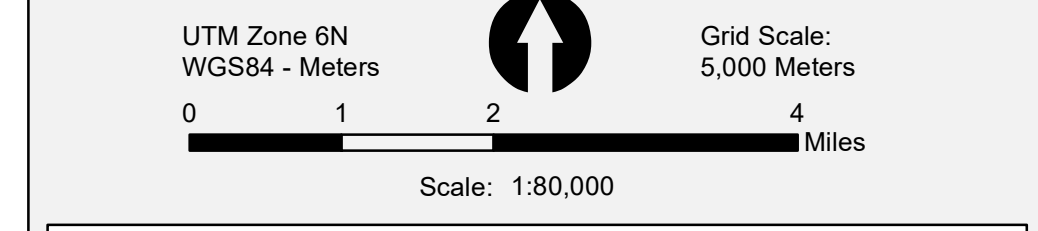
